

A Message from the Mayor

With the end of 2017 fast approaching I would like to take this opportunity to recap 2017 and provide you with a few friendly winter reminders.

The Village of Spencerport has celebrated their Sesquicentennial along with the Town of Ogden's Bicentennial all year long with various events throughout the year with great success. The Village of Spencerport's Municipal Electric Department also celebrated their 100-year anniversary with a well-attended luncheon in early October. I continue to be proud to have the opportunity to represent this fine community.

In addition, just a few reminders as winter fast approaches.

No Parking of all Village Streets from 2:00 a.m. – 6:00 a.m. from November 15th – April 15th. This Village Law is necessary to aid in snow removal efforts.

Please do not plow, push, or blow snow from driveways into the street, not only does this create a potential danger, but the NYS vehicle and traffic law prohibits these deposits in a public street.

Please be patient with our snowplow and salt truck drivers, please stay at least 100 feet back as the vehicle may stop or back up. If you cannot see the driver of the truck – he cannot see you either.

Should your mailbox be damaged during snow plowing the Village will replace the mailbox with a standard rural mailbox with a 4'x4' wood post as a courtesy.

Lawns at the road that are damaged by plowing will be repaired in the spring once all threat of snow has passed and topsoil becomes available and as time permits.

Please help to maintain fire hydrant accessibility to the fire hydrant nearest to your home or place of business. Shoveling snow away from the hydrant will help maintain accessibility to the hydrant in the event of a fire.

Lastly with colder temperatures there will be an increased load to our electric energy demand requiring the Village to purchase additional power on the open market. These necessary purchases do influence your purchase power adjustment calculation (PPAC) found on your electric bill every month.

Please have a safe and enjoyable holiday and winter season.
